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## VELFREY VINEYARD

Established by Fiona and Andy Mounsey in 2016, the vineyard occupies a gentle south facing slope in the south Pembrokeshire countryside. They have over 4,250 vines planted across nearly 3 acres. The vines are planted in clay loam, and Pembrokeshire sunshine combined with coastal breezes produces perfect ripening conditions and lead to wines of the highest quality. Wine is made using traditional method and aged on the lees for 18 months. As a result, we have a complex sparkling wine with notes of nectarine, wild strawberry and spiced orange peel.

## WHITE CASTLE VINEYARD

Founded and run by Robb and Nicola Merchant, the vineyard currently boasts 13,500 vines across roughly 10 acres of south and north-facing slopes on the outskirts of Abergavenny. In 2021, White Castle became the first Welsh vineyard to win a Gold Award at the Decanter World Wine Awards. Siegerrebe 2023 has distinct aromas of peach, lychee, orange blossom and nectarine. A fresh and elegant palate with balanced acidity and a slightly spiced finish. Regent 2021 has black cherry, blackberry, bay leaf and some spice notes from subtle use of oak. A light, Beaujolais-style red with smooth tannins, fruit forward flavours and vibrant acidity.

# BEST OF WELSH

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## GWINLLAN Y DYFFRYN / VALE VINEYARD

Founded and run by Gwen and Rhys Davies, who both come from local farming backgrounds and planted their first vines in 2019. The vineyard features 8,000 vines planted across 5 acres of south-west facing slopes and uses pedigree Llŷn sheep to graze between the rows during winter, which naturally manages weeds and fertilises the soil.

Solaris has delicate floral scents of apple blossom, elderflower, nectarine and fresh pear. Light-bodied, crisp and dry with vibrant acidity and a lingering finish.

Robin Goch is an interesting blend. Smoky-sweet black cherry, blackberry and blueberry aromas. Medium-bodied, smooth and juicy with a generous finish.

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## RATHFINNY ESTATE

Husband and wife, Mark and Sarah Driver, established the Rathfinny Wine Estate in 2010 with the express intention of producing some of the world's finest quality English sparkling wines. Once a working arable farm in the South Downs of Sussex, Rathfinny's first 50 acres of vines were planted in April 2012. All their grapes come from a single-site vineyard, which grew to be 230 acres large. Vines are set out on an ideal south-facing slope, just three miles from the English Channel where its unique micro-climate and the free-draining chalky soils create superb grape-growing conditions.

## WHITEWOLFE ESTATE

Whitewolfe Estate, located in Kent's North Downs, is an emerging name in English wine. Founded by Clare Whitehead and Luke Wolfe, the 10-hectare vineyard benefits from a unique microclimate and chalk-rich soils, ideal for Chardonnay. Planted in 2020 with seven Burgundy clones, the vineyard produces wines that balance freshness with complexity. Their meticulous approach from clone selection to cellar experimentation yields refined Chardonnays with flinty minerality and citrus elegance. Despite its youth, Whitewolfe has already gained critical acclaim, showcasing the potential of Kent's Kit's Coty region.

# A TASTE FOR ADVENTURE

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We wanted to highlight a couple of wines on our list that are a bit different. Chosen for their individuality, character, and sense of discovery, these bottles showcase regions, varieties, and winemaking approaches that may sit slightly outside of the familiar.

SAUVIGNON BLANC	<i>Amphora</i> , Gabriëlskloof, Walker Bay, South Africa, 2024 White Wine	£84
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This unusual Sauvignon Blanc was fermented in amphora clay pots, allowing for micro-oxidation. The result shows a more textured, savory side of the variety. Citrus peel, stone fruit, and gentle herbal notes combine with bright acidity, offering an alternative expression that reflects both thoughtful winemaking and a willingness to explore beyond the expected.

GARANDMAK, VOSKEAK	<i>Voski</i> , Zorah, Yeghegnadzor, Vayots Dzor, Armenia, 2023 White Wine	£116
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In 2006, Zorik Gharibian who was born in Iran and later found himself living in Venice, planted a six-hectare vineyard in Armenia's Yeghegnadzor Valley, at an elevation of 1,370 metres, close to Mount Ararat. Both ancient native grape varieties, Voskèak and Garandmak, have been present in Armenia for millennia. The exceptional terroir of Vayotz Dzor, with its high altitudes and elevated daytime temperatures but cool nights, yield distinctively balanced fruit in this region and highlight the full potential of these grapes.

Chosen for its sense of place and character, this high-altitude Armenian white brings together freshness, texture, and mineral depth. The nose boasts aromas of lemon, pear, peach and pomelo. On the palate, the finish is long and complex with a soft and subtle minerality.

Bedoba, which translates to 'Day of Luck', is a Georgian winery primarily dedicated to making wines from the country's indigenous Saperavi grape, partially vinified in traditional qvevri vessels. A small percentage of the grapes are whole bunch fermented, while another is left to dry naturally on the vines until November, ensuring a fine balance of the grape's savoury and spicy characteristics.

Stainless steel tanks and clay qvevri are used for fermentation, exemplifying the blend of innovation and tradition. The nose opens with a powerful savoury-spicy bouquet of blackberries, herbs, flowers and black pepper. The palate has a creamy, juicy texture, ripe tannins and black fruit flavours.

La Villaudière is owned by Jean-Marie Reverdy together with his sons Guillaume and Baptiste. The unique location offers stunning views of the famous Sancerre Hill and its vineyards.

While most of us associate Sancerre with vibrant and bright Sauvignon Blanc, a few producers in the region choose to make fresh and elegant wine using Pinot Noir grapes.

On the nose, expressive aromas of ripe red fruits are elevated by smoky notes of roasted coffee. Soft with a silky texture, the wine opens up with beautiful volume and is full of finesse and elegance.
